



Supply Checklist for Emergencies & Adverse Weather

Are these supplies prepared for adverse weather events and power loss?

- Strensiq® (asfotase alfa)
- Syringes
- Alcohol wipes
- Cooler and ice packs
- Dry bags
- Bluetooth or Wi-Fi thermometers with humidity sensors (or traditional for backup)
- Generator
- Refrigerator battery (deep cycle battery)
- Ziploc bags and storage containers
- Car/Portable refrigerator
- Portable solar panels for portable fridge
- Card with PANTHERx Rare Pharmacy, local pharmacy, fire station, & hospital numbers
- Cooler and ice packs at a family member or friend's house

Know where you can store medication **in case of a power outage**



Set up weather alerts from FEMA, NWS and NOAA.



Reach out to your local power company about their priority power restoration list.



Home generators are an option for keeping medication cool **during power outages**.



Having a sealable container or dry bag (airtight) is useful for flooding.
