\$3,000 scholarship

Must have been diagnosed with and/or been actively treated for cancer or chronic disease within the past five years & must be pursuing an Associate's degree or higher.

Must be an incoming or a current student of an **Undergraduate or Graduate Program of a New Jersey College or University**. Applicant must have an intellectual disability, physical disability, or psychiatric disability.

Must have an identified disability (defined as someone who has, or considers themselves to have, a long-term or recurring issue that impacts major life activities).
